AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Age Divisions
Sub Bantam (born 2001-later)
Bantam (born 1999 and 2000)
Midget (born 1997–1998)
Youth (born 1995–1996)
Intermediate (born 1993–1994)
Young (born 1991-1992)
* athletes born in 1990 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 8/2/2009



Individuals: Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States, and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the Bantam and Midget divisions may compete in a maximum of three events, including relays. Competitors in the Youth, Intermediate, and Young divisions may compete in a maximum of four events, including relays. Combined events are not included in the event count. All athletes must be 2009 members of USATF in good standing.

Relay Teams: Only registered 2009 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership. Visit www.usatf.org and click on "Products/Services" to become a member.

ENTRY PROCESS:

Electronic Entries: USATF Indiana Clubs and unattached athletes must submit their entries electronically beginning no later than **June 1, 2009**. The deadline for the submission of all electronic entries is **Monday June 15, 2009 at 9:00pm**. The standard entry fee for electronic entries is \$6.00/event and \$24.00/relay. If you miss the electronic entry deadline and we allow you to enter the meet electronically, you will be charged \$10.00/event and \$40.00/relay team. The link for entries is displayed on www.inusatf.org website. **All entrants must present a paper copy of the entry signed by a parent (not coach) at the meet due to new drug testing regulations by USATF.** Paper copy with waiver and signature block can be downloaded at www.inusatf.org website. Blank forms will be available at the meet.

Note: All necessary follow-up paperwork, including all listed requirements (e.g., electronic receipts, USATF membership number, BC's for new members etc.), must be received at the USATF Indiana specified location within 72 hours after each electronic entry are submitted. Under all circumstances, paperwork from all electronic entries must be received by 5:00pm on Thursday, June 18, 2009. There are no refunds or exchanges.

All entries must be made using the official entry form. Proof of Birth (copy of birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver's license, or U.S. government identification) is required and must be submitted with each entry form (even if it was already submitted to the membership chair). For relay team entry, please follow the instructions on the official Relay Roster Form. All forms need to be mailed to Danelle Readinger 112 Adams Blvd Terre Haute, IN 46803

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three individuals and the top three relay teams in each event of each age division.

ADVANCEMENTS: The top 6 individuals and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region 7 Championships to be held on **July 9 – 12, 2009** at **Plainfield Central High School, Plainfield, IL.** **All advancement/entry forms for the USATF Region 7 Championships must be completed, paid for, and submitted (cash or money order only) prior to leaving Columbus East High School, Columbus, IN.**

The National Championships will be held from Tuesday, July 28 to Sunday, August 2 at Irwin Belk Stadium – North Carolina A&T State University, Greensboro, NC. The top 3 athletes at the Region 7 Championships will qualify for the National Championships. Information is available at:

Hammer Throw (will start after Discus is completed)

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN: At 30 minutes prior to each event

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 45 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$ 5.00 Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes. You can pick up your bib number at packet pick-up.

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted. In addition, event results will be posted at www.inusatf.org.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$100.00 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

GATE ADMISSION FEES: Pre-School children and under are free. School Age Children and up are **\$5.00**/person. Only those coaches who present a 2009 USATF background checked membership card will be admitted FREE. Coaches' passes will be issued for those who are qualified.
